DS9132J | DS9139J (ONLINE) ORGANISATIONAL TRANSFORMATION AND IGNATIAN SPIRITUALITY

In this unit, the student will carry out a participative action research intervention in the student's own organisation, with the support of group spiritual direction. This intervention is designed to bring about an organisational transformation. The student will articulate how the intervention evolved and the subsequent impact of the intervention.

Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this unit, it is expected that students will be able to:

- design and undertake an effective intervention in an organisation, using appropriate action research methods
- 2 analyse the organisational intervention through developing, testing and modifying working hypotheses as a basis for further action
- 3 illustrate, by way of a work journal, how they have provided effective leadership of organisational transformation
- 4 provide evidence of having worked transparently and constructively with challenges, criticisms and conflict
- 5 demonstrate how Ignatian spirituality was integrated into and informed their organisational transformation project.

This unit can be face-to-face weekly for 12 weeks or online.
